<p>Apply by choosing a course on NTO.ie/courses webpage and clicking the button Apply.</p> 	Applications open in November and remain open until end of September
Automated response received acknowledging receipt of application.	Following application submission
Contact Made ETB makes contact with applicant and applicant submits information required for registration. This involves inputting basic detail such as course, location, name, address, date of birth, PPS number, mobile number, e-mail address.	Following application submission
Submission of Supporting Documents. These documents can include: portfolio assessment, submission of a personal statement, non-evaluative engagement, further requirements e.g. Self-declared medical statement signed by their GP, Garda Vetting if required.	Following application submission
Selection Process Applicants are invited for consultative engagement / interview / audition where required.	Following application submission
Provisional Offer of a Place Offer of provisional places to applicants as appropriate.	May - September
Offer of Place Offer of place is issued based on successful interview and meeting entry requirements	August - September
Registration and Induction commences, and students start on their chosen course.	September
